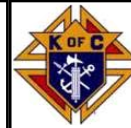

**Monstrance Acquired for Saint
 Anthony of Padua Parish**

This antique Monstrance was acquired by Monsignor Dreasen from a wealthy widow's estate in Connecticut. It was hand-made in Germany by a tinsmith in the 1850's and has embedded enameled renderings of Saint Anthony of Padua, the Blessed Mother, Saint Peter, Saint Paul and others. It also has several amethysts around its base and zircons surround the opening where the Sacred Host is placed. The detailed history of the Monstrance is locked up in the late widow's safe which Msgr. Dreasen hope to have access to in the near future. It is truly a beautiful work of art. Bob Slingo, PGK saw it and was astounded by it's brilliance. Our parish's Nocturnal Adoration Society is accepting donations to help offset its cost.
