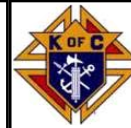

A bus load of pro-life supporters, including several members of Fr. Judge K of C council and St. Anthony's parishioners, joined bus loads of people from across Long Island. After meeting with Congressman Steve Israel's aide in his office to voice their opposition to Roe v. Wade, the St. Anthony's group rendezvoused with hundreds of thousands of marchers (predominantly young) all over the United States at the National Mall in Washington, D.C. for the 38th annual March for Life. For the St. Anthony's contingent, the day started with a 4:30 AM Mass celebrated by Fr. Frank Grieco. Father provided the inspiration for the day. In Washington the day started with a Mass at the national basilica. Mass was attended by hundreds of seminarians, deacons and priests, scores of bishops and four cardinals -- among them Cardinal O'Malley from Boston. The homilist was Cardinal Daniel DiNardo, Archbishop of Galveston-Houston and head of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' Pro-Life Committee. After Mass, they joined more than 200,000 supporters at the National Mall. Some carried signs, some chanted various pro-life slogans, some prayed, and others simply supported the cause through their presence. Notable speakers at the 38th annual march in 2011 included House Majority Leader Eric Cantor, House Majority Whip Kevin McCarthy, and other members of Congress. (Photos and article by Bob Slingo)
